**FES Fellow Membership** is awarded to Professional Engineer members in recognition of their high character and distinguished achievements. It is desirable that the candidate has a well-rounded record of achievement in education, employment, professional and public service activities.

**FICE Governor A.W. Gilchrist** is presented annually to a member of the engineering profession who exemplifies the spirit of public service that betters humankind, therefore, bringing honor to the engineering profession.

**FES Engineer of the Year** is presented to one member of FES that best exemplifies the ideal image of the Professional Engineer.

**FES Young Engineer of the Year** is an opportunity to distinguish an up-and-coming leader from your chapter. The award honors the FES member who is **34 years of age or younger**, who best exemplifies the ideal image of the young engineer.

**FES Award for Outstanding Service to the Profession** is presented to an individual who has, by virtue of his/her service, had a significant positive impact on the engineering profession. The award may be given in recognition of an individual who has established a consistent record of service over a long period of time, or to an individual whose contribution is short-lived, but exceptional.

**FES Award for Outstanding Technical Achievement** is presented to an individual who, as project engineer or project manager, has achieved particular distinction in his/her own technical field and mode of practice, which may be government, education, industry, construction or private practice. The technical achievement shall be one that enhances the engineering profession and contributes to the good of the public.

**FICE Community Service Award** recognizes FICE members for their accomplishments in community service.

**FPEI Industry Engineer of the Year** recognizes an engineer who has made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of engineers in industry.

**NSPE Mentor of the Year** is presented annually to the one member of NSPE who best exemplifies the ideal image of a mentor. The ideal candidate should have a record of achievement in offering guidance to and fostering development among engineering professionals.

**FICE Professional Development Award** recognizes an engineering firm that encourages participation in professional and technical societies, civic activities and in continuing education.

**FPEG Government Engineer of the Year** recognizes an engineer who made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of engineers in government.

**FPEG Professional Development Award** recognizes a government agency that has made contributions to the advancement and improvement of the engineering profession through its employment practices and professional development policies.

**FECON Professional Development Award** recognizes a construction employer of engineering personnel who has made the most outstanding contribution to the advancement and improvement of the engineering profession through its employment policies and practices.

**Chapter ACE Award** emphasizes individual chapter activities and their involvement in the community.

**K-12 Engineer Volunteer of the Year – NEW** – Recognizes the FES member who has volunteered his or her time to introduce engineering and technology concepts and activities to K-12 students.

**K-12 Teacher of the Year for Engineering – NEW** – Recognizes a K-12 teacher who creatively incorporates or promotes engineering and technology concepts and activities in her or her lessons in the classroom.
