

Commission on Legislative and Government Affairs (CLGA)

Official Responsibilities of the Committee

The purpose of the commission is to provide the Florida Engineering Society with maximum participation in and proper coordination of its legislative and government relations program.

The commission shall be responsible for:

1. Drafting and seeking introduction of and developing support for the passage of legislation or the adoption of rules that impact the health, safety, and welfare of the public or affect the engineering profession.
2. The commission will insure coordination with other professions, organizations, and interest groups and enlist their cooperation and support in legislative and administrative measures of mutual interest or concern.
3. The commission will prepare and present a written summary report at the Society's annual meeting covering the activities of the Division of Public Affairs during the preceding year. The report should contain recommendations of the commission as to the necessary funding level of the division for the coming year.

Duties

Year- Round: Be aware and become familiar with legislation that affects engineers.

Quarterly: Meetings or conference calls to discuss issues.

Monthly: Closer to legislative session (February and March) additional time will be needed to participate on frequent conference calls.

Volunteer Time Commitment

A maximum of one hour per month is requested.

Quarterly conference calls with monthly conference calls during legislative session.
