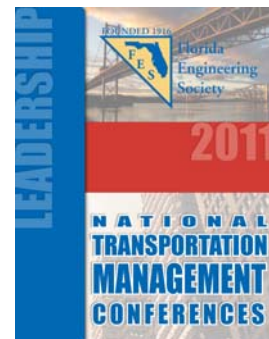

The Florida Board of Professional Engineers delayed action on a proposed rule to implement Chapter 471.0195, F.S., at its December 1, 2010 meeting. After extensive discussion on problems associated with writing a rule that could practically implement the statute, the Board deferred action. The Board further directed staff to inform Florida licensees that no Florida PE would be disciplined for violation of Section 471.0195, F.S. not taking a Florida Building Code course until a rule is adopted. The major sticking point was how to define any specialized or advanced course and apply it in a practical way to a licensee's area of practice. The Board will continue to work on the rule and bring it back before the board at its next meeting.
